



Stoplight Behavior System

The behavior management system is used in all four of the preschool classes. The bulletin board at the front of the room shows a stoplight with three colors: green, yellow, and red. Everyone begins each day with "green for go" showing. If a child's behavior isn't safe or listening to the teacher, the color changes to yellow, which is the first caution. If another behavior problem occurs that day, the color will change to red.

We also use the stoplight system to reward students who behave appropriately. If this system sounds confusing, you may want to visit our class and observe the stoplight system in action. It's actually quite simple and allows the teachers to devote more time to teaching and less time to handling behavior problems.
